GST overhaul likely, regardless of election result

The controversial Goods and Services Tax (GST) is set for an overhaul

after the new government swears in, irrespective of who comes to power.

Top finance ministry officials said they have been working on GST on the

premise that more of goods currently in the 28 per cent luxury bracket would be

brought down to a lower rate and that the GST median rate now at 18 per cent

could eventually be reduced.

"There will be a continuation of GST reforms regardless of who forms the

government. The aim is to slowly reduce rates and slabs," said an official. While

the Congress manifesto has promised to tweak the current four-rate tax structure

into a two-rate one, the BJP manifesto has remained delightfully vague but

promised continued simplification of GST.
