(MSME) in the area of trade remedies such as anti dumping duty,

countervailing duty and safeguard measures.

Remedial trade measures available to address trade distortions to the

domestic industry include anti-dumping duty, countervailing duty and

measures including safeguard duties and quantitative restrictions. India's
