Subject: Conditions on import of Refined Palm Oil

Central Government vide Notification No. 39/2015-2020 dated 8th January, 2020 amended the Import Policy of refined palm oil under Exim code 151190 from 'Free' to 'Restricted'.

- 2. Import of refined palm oil under the above mentioned Exim code will be permitted subject to the following conditions:
 - The applications for import authorization should be accompanied with prepurchase agreement and details of the import of the above items for past three years.
 - ii. Validity period of import licenses/authorizations for refined palm oil will be 06 months in place of usual 18 months.
 - iii. Total non-utilisation of import authorization by the applicant will lead to disqualification of the importer from getting any further license for these items in future.
 - iv. Customs will be required to diligently enforce the Rules of Origin criteria for import of these items originating from Nepal and Bangladesh.
